- Demonstrate respect for all members of the Calthorpe Park Community in all forms of online communication including social media and WhatsApp groups
- Be tolerant of people's differences, respecting the views, feelings and needs of my peers
- To not be unkind to other students, either in person or online
- Take responsibility for my behaviour and attitude

- Attend Parents'/Carers consultation events and any meetings about my child's progress either by phone, video call or in person
