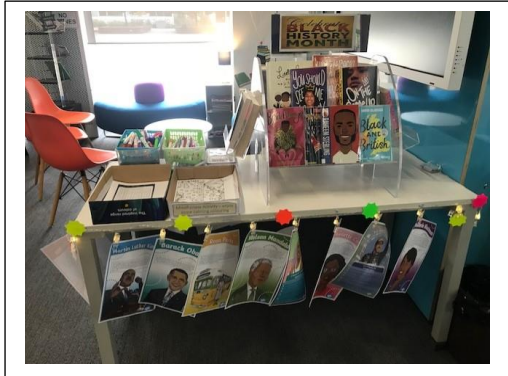


## Library News

The library continues to be **available before, during and after school**.

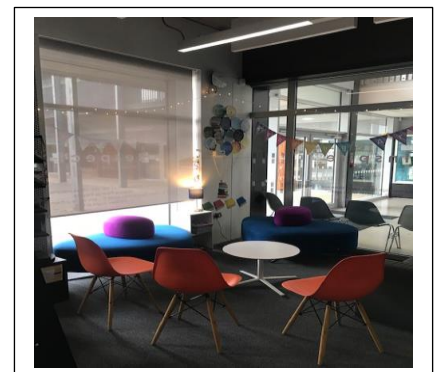

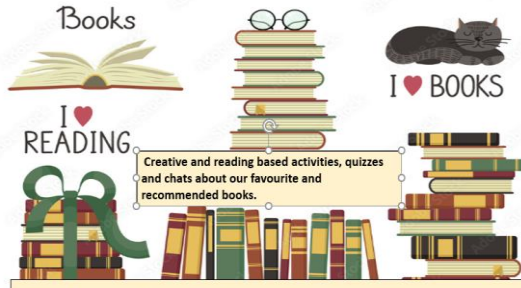
### **A quick reminder about opening times:**
