Dear Parents and Carers.

We are excited to announce a special fundraising event taking place on **Friday 18th July – CPS Rocks!** The day will compose of a House based event called “**Our House**” in which students will spend some of the day with their tutor group working collaboratively on different challenges and a fantastic **afternoon concert** featuring performances by our talented staff and students. The day will be a Mufti (non-school uniform) day.

We are kindly asking for a **voluntary contribution of £2 per child**, which will cover both the mufti day and entry to the concert. This will be able to be paid via Scopay in the two weeks leading up to the event, but we will also accept £2 donations on the day, which can be collected during tutor time. Even on non-uniform days, schools want to maintain a sense of pride and professionalism. Appropriate dress reflects the values of the school community and prepares students for expectations in the wider world.

Students should wear casual and appropriate clothing that reflects a respectful and inclusive school environment. Suitable attire includes jeans or trousers, knee-length skirts or dresses, t-shirts or tops with sleeves, and comfortable footwear such as trainers or flat shoes. Clothing should be clean, tidy, and free from offensive language, images, or logos. Items that are not appropriate include crop tops, low-cut tops, very short skirts or shorts of inappropriate length (including running shorts), ripped clothing that exposes undergarments, or anything that promotes alcohol, drugs, violence, or discriminatory messages. No midriffs on display. Shorts, if worn, must be an appropriate length and material (nearer to the knee than the hip), not running shorts. The goal is to enjoy a relaxed dress code while maintaining a standard that supports a positive and focused learning atmosphere. Rules surrounding make-up and jewellery still apply as if they were in full school uniform.

As we will be spending time outdoors in the afternoon for CPS Rocks, students are encouraged to wear a sun hat or cap when outside and to apply sunscreen to protect themselves from sunburn.

We hope all students will join in the spirit of the day by dressing in sensible casual clothes and enjoying the music and celebration in the afternoon.
