SUMMER UNIFORM

As the Summer term approaches, I wanted to update you regarding our summer uniform expectations when students return after the Easter break.

All students can continue to wear their current uniform, as they have been for the school year thus far. For those who would like to adopt our summer uniform, they are able to do so, starting from Tuesday 22 April. This consists of wearing a white CPS polo shirt (with their house colour logo) instead of a shirt and tie (the maroon/black sweatshirt is still required). The CPS polo shirts can be ordered from our uniform supplier, SWI.

As the weather improves, formal black shorts can also be worn (as they can be at any point during the year), and should be worn instead of formal trousers/skirts. Students wishing to wear this item will still be required to wear black socks with their school shoes.

Over the holidays, it is a great opportunity to re-visit all items of uniform and equipment that may need replacing in preparation for the new term. With that in mind, please don't forget that we have very clear expectations reading uniform. I have attached the [poster](#) that I sent out in January as a reminder of what these are. I would draw particular attention to **acrylic nails and false eye lashes** which are **not allowed** to be worn at school. In addition to this, the only jewellery that is permitted is a **one stud/sleeper in each ear**.

Parental support is essential in helping us maintain high standards of uniform and keeping our students fully equipped for their learning in lessons. We are grateful to all parents who work in partnership with us to ensure that your child/children are ready for the 'business of learning' when they arrive to school each day.

Finally, I hope you and your families have a restful break and we look forward to welcoming all students back on Tuesday 22 April ready to start the day at 8.40am with morning registration.
