SCHOOL UNIFORM

As we are now fast approaching the end of the first half term of the school year I felt it an opportune time to both celebrate and re-iterate our expectations regarding school uniform.

Firstly, a heartfelt thank you to all of you who have supported us with upholding the high standards of school uniform. It is greatly appreciated. When I wrote to you previously I referenced a uniform review, so please be ready with your feedback when I send out a link next week to all parent/carers. It will form the basis of us looking at our current uniform and how we may change it in the future.

However, despite us being six weeks into the new school year there are still some issues regarding the correct uniform being worn. Thank you to those parents/carers who have liaised with their child's tutor and/or Head of House to update us as to when these issues will be resolved. For those who have been unable to do so, we have purchased uniform items that we will be distributing to students after half term if they have been unable to source appropriate items or are unwilling to do so. We have asked all tutors to record any issues next week, so please expect correspondence from us if there are issues that are still ongoing. I am hoping that these will be few in number. Just so that there are no misunderstandings, our expectations are that students should have/be wearing:

- A rucksack and not a bag
- Shirt & Tie (years 7-10)
- A school jumper
- Black socks
- Jewellery – single stud/sleeper per ear
