Year 11 Leaving Arrangements

We are acutely aware that your child's time at Calthorpe Park is drawing to a close and we wanted to provide information relating to a number of important events that are coming up over the next few months.

Examination Arrangements

Many of you will already be aware that external examinations are underway with the vast majority of all practical assessments having already been completed. The main body of written examinations will commence on Tuesday 5th May and your child's examination timetable will be available via EdulinkOne. The general examination timetable for Summer 2026 is available to access through our school website - Information - Exam arrangements.

Please ensure they have all the pre-requisite equipment they need including a clear pencil case. Exam timetables should be consulted the night before each exam to confirm seating arrangements as these can be subject to change. This will ensure the examination experience is as stress-free as possible.
